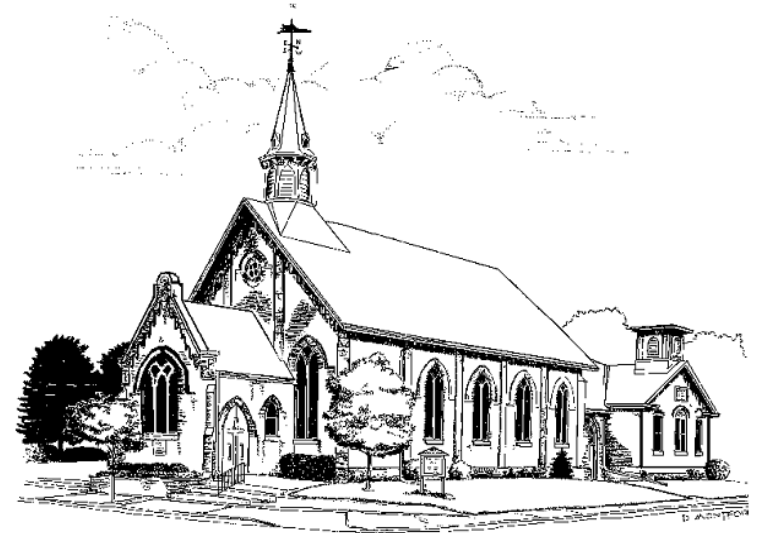

Opening Words

Leader: On this third Sunday in Lent, we continue our Lenten journey of self-discovery.

Leader: Like God provided for his people in their wilderness time with water from the rock and manna from the heavens, God continues to provide for all our needs today.

People: God may not give us everything we want, but he makes sure we have everything we need.

Leader: In Jesus, God also provides the “living waters” from which we can freely drink to nourish our souls.

People: We know that it is God – and God alone who provides for all our physical needs, as well as providing the means for our eternal salvation through Christ.

Leader: These are free gifts, provided by a loving God; therefore, we're able to boast only in God – and not in ourselves. Let us pray...

Prayer: Gracious Lord, we thank you that, on a daily basis, you so generously provide for all our needs; but most of all, we thank you for Jesus and for the salvation that is ours because of him.
