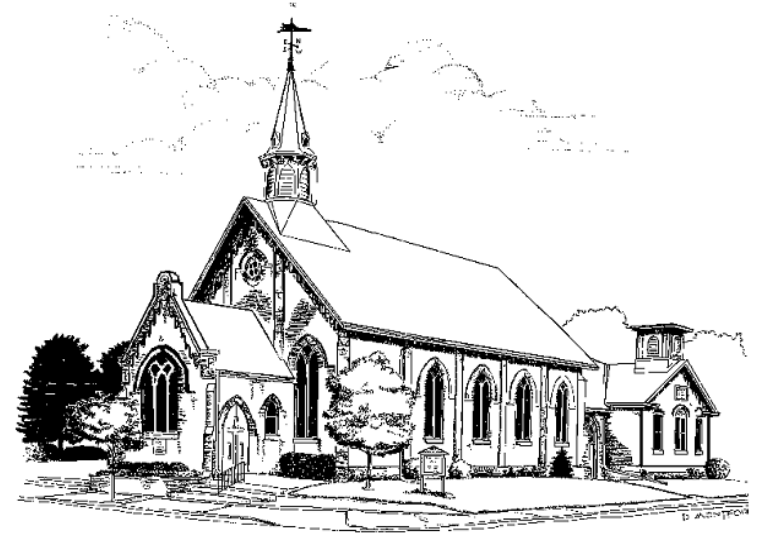

## **Mission Awareness Sunday (April 26)**

**The Rev. Mark Hoogsteen Memorial Trust Fund** was created in celebration of the life of Rev. Mark who served as a minister here at Knox. This Trust Fund provides an ongoing testament to Mark's involvement and his passion for mission and outreach within the framework of a Christian setting. Two maximum awards up to \$1,000.00 are given annually to applicants supporting a mission trip, outreach project, educational workshop or conference, internationally, nationally or locally that is sponsored within the Presbyterian Church in Canada or an accredited organization. It must benefit one's understanding of mission and outreach work.

**Our first candidate today is Rev. Bernie Skelding**, the minister at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church in Niagara on the Lake. His church is introducing a new program this summer called "Grand Bible Camp" where Grandparents with their Grandchildren attend Camp together. As the "younger generation.... is progressively less involved with religion and less likely to report a faith affiliation," this camp will be "leveraging limited grandparent/grandchild time to encourage a positive and healthy faith and spiritual formation."

Bernie is unable to attend and has sent us a video to share with you!

**Our second Candidate is Shannon Shuell**, the Community Resource Manager at Open Doors at St. Christopher's Church in Burlington. This program offers Food Resources and Community Meals, a free Clothing Store, Ontario Energy Support and Seasonal Programs.
