Camp Kintail Mission Project

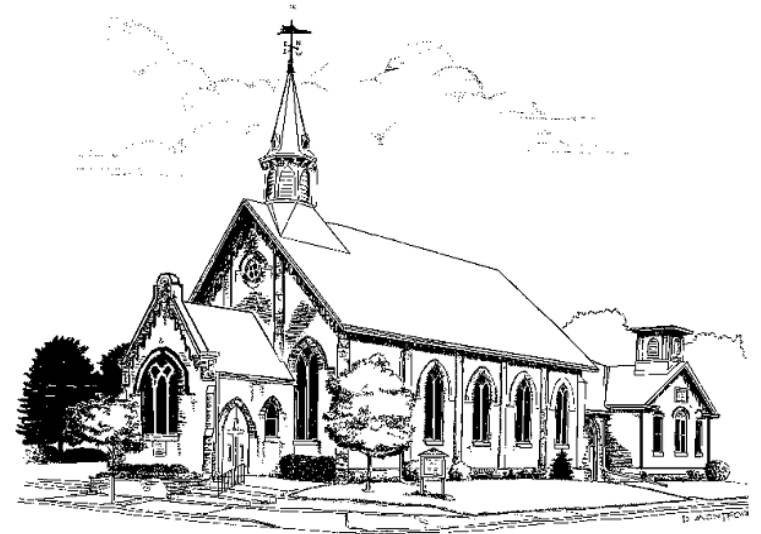
