There is a basket in the narthex to drop your donations.

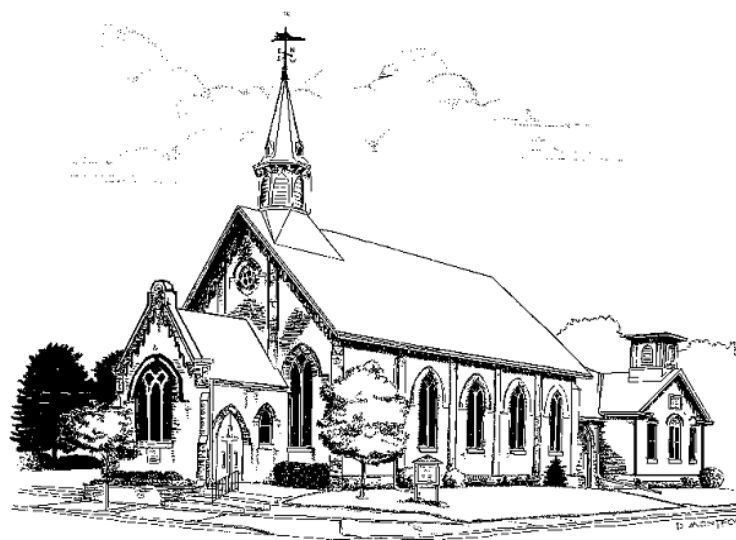
