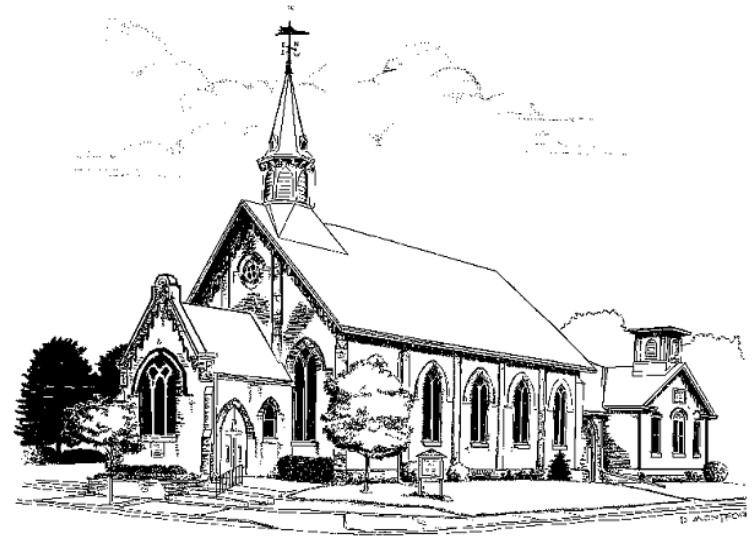
Scripture Readers Needed for October, November and December. If you are interested in reading, please contact Kathy in the church office.
